The story behind Ironing Relief. In August 2014 ISIS invaded the Sinjar Mountain region in Iraq, home to the Yazidi people, an ethnic minority who have lived there for centuries. Tens of thousands shot and killed where they stood. Women and girls were loaded into buses and taken to be sold on markets as sex slaves and workers. While ISIS have now lost their strongholds in Iraq and Syria, they still exist, and it is estimated that there are around 3,000 girls still in captivity.
